Furthermore, you should also clean your house and the pet's bedding with the help of a formulation that contains peppermint oil for flea control.

What Essential Oils Are Good For Flea Control?

A word of CAUTION: You should never use peppermint, pennyroyal, and tea tree essential oils on your dog or cat. These oils should only be used when cleaning their

1. Lavender:

Lavender essential oil is nurturing and gentle to human beings. It is also an excellent insect repellent. Although, when using lavender for animals, start with minimal quantities while testing their sensitivity to the oil. While you might not notice any harm on your pet, it is unhealthy to over-expose your pets to the essential oils.

2. Cedarwood:

Just like lavender oil, cedarwood essential oil can help you in flea control. As a matter of fact, you can replace lavender for dogs' fleas control with cedarwood essential oil when making a deterrent spray. It comes with a woody, relaxing fragrance but unlike us, cats don't get soothed by these fragrances.

Simple DIY Essential-Oil-Based Flea Deterrent Spray

Flea deterrent spray is far much better to washing or brushing your cat or dog with the essential oil formulations. The spray will improve the coat of your pet and prevent over-exposing their coats into the oils.

Ingredients:

- Three drops of lavender;
- One glass spray bottle;
- 1 quart of fresh water;
- 1 cup of apple cider vinegar.

Direction:

- Start by mixing your cup of cider vinegar with the quart of fresh water.
- Consider adding in the three drops of lavender oil for fleas control and mix it up.
- Add the mixture into the spray bottle.

- You can then mist your cat or dog with the spray. You should be careful not to get the spray into their nose, eyes, or ears. In general, avoid getting the spray into their face.
